

# Learn 2 Ride, Inc. <sup>TM</sup>

## Prepare for your *RiderCourse*

Thank you for your interest in a *RiderCourse*. Whether you are a potential new rider, a rider with minimal experience, an experienced rider who has taken time off or just not sure if motorcycling is for you, the *RiderCourse* is an important first step.

Preparation is a key element to motorcycling. Not only does your bike need to be ready, but you need to be ready to ride.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS**

#### **To Qualify for the Road Test Waiver Option to the NYS DMV Road Test**

- Participation in this course requires physical stamina, motor coordination and mental alertness.
- **YOU MUST** possess a **current, valid** New York State (or other state / country) Driver's License
- A New York State Motorcycle Learner's Permit should be obtained from the NYS DMV prior to attending. The permit is not required for registration, but is required to apply for the road test waiver of the NYS DMV road test
- **YOU MUST be 16 years of age or older. 16 & 17 must bring a parent to the first session**
- **YOU MUST:** Be able to ride a bicycle
- **COST:** \$275.00 due at time of registration
- **CLASS SIZE:** **12 students** (Maximum)
- **COURSE LOCATION:** First classroom session: Monroe Community College's Applied Technology Center, 2485 West Henrietta Rd, Rochester, NY. \* Note - This is not the main Brighton Campus!
- **HAVE YOUR RIDING GEAR AVAILABLE FOR ALL SESSIONS.**
- **REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:**
  - **Helmet:** DOT approved with face shield or approved safety glasses or goggles.  
*Loan helmets are available if necessary*
  - **Gloves:** Leather (preferably) or cotton---**no fingerless gloves**
  - **Jeans:** Denim or other sturdy material—**NO HOLES & NO FLARE-LEG!!**
  - **Jacket:** Denim or other sturdy material or long sleeved shirt or sweatshirt
  - **Boots:** **Must** cover the ankle and have a flat heel **NO SNEAKERS**
- **MOTORCYCLES ARE PROVIDED FOR THIS COMBINATION CLASSROOM / HANDS ON TRAINING PROGRAM**
- **ATTENDANCE:** **Mandatory** for all sessions, classroom and range! Arrive on time and be prepared! Be sure you can attend **all** sessions!!!!
- **You must bring your Valid NYS Driver's License to your Course!**

**Driving Directions:**

**From West (Buffalo)**

Take Thruway 90 east to exit 46; take 390 north to exit 16, the second East Henrietta Rd. (Rt. 15 A) exit; turn left and continue south on 15A to Crittenden Road; turn right on Crittenden and continue to 2nd light; turn left onto West Henrietta Road; Applied Technologies Center entrance on right (after Friendly's Restaurant).

**From East (Syracuse)**

Take Thruway 90 west to exit 46 and proceed as above.

**From South (Geneseo)**

Take 390 north to Rochester and proceed as above.

**From North (Greece)**

Take 390 South to exit 16A (West Henrietta Rd); turn right at West Henrietta Rd light and proceed to the Applied Technologies Center entrance on right (after Friendly's Restaurant).

**From Brockport/Spencerport**

Take Route 31 east to 390 south; take exit 16A (West Henrietta Rd); turn right at West Henrietta Rd light and proceed to the Applied Technologies Center entrance on right (after Friendly's Restaurant).
